What's a paint out? Artists begin their day with a blank canvas that is stamped at check-in with the day's date. Artists then paint outdoors (en plein air) finishing the painting on that day. Finished works, that are still "wet", will be available for purchase at the "Painting the Past" Exhibit and Fundraiser at 6:00 PM at Charlevoix's Historic Depot. Artists price their own paintings. The Historical Society will take 50% commission on works sold. Works not sold must be picked up by the artists or they become the property of the Charlevoix Historical Society.

ARTIST PARTICIPATION

Participation is limited to the first 30 artists to register via our website. There is a \$10 registration fee. Participating artists will be included in the "Painting the Past" program.
