A Guided Tour of Castle Farms

And now for something completely different. Next month, Kathleen Paterka, wife of Society treasurer Steve Paterka, will present a guided tour of the Castle Farms complex three miles south of Charlevoix where she is employed as an administrator/staff writer. Kathleen is co-author, with Castle Farms owner Linda Mueller, of the recently published 88-pp. "For the Love of a Castle," a full color illustrated history of the rise, gradual derelict fall and astonishing resurrection of the Loeb Farms estate farm buildings, originally built by Albert Loeb, vice-president of Sears Roebuck, in 1918. Accompanied by an array of archival and recent images, Kathleen will trace the Castle Farms area story through its four owners: Mr. Loeb, metal sculptor John van Haver, rock concert impresario Art Reibel, and now castle enthusiast Linda Mueller and her husband Richard.
